The Kentish Players are performing "Little Shop of Horrors" at The Hazlitt Theatre from 22nd to 25th June

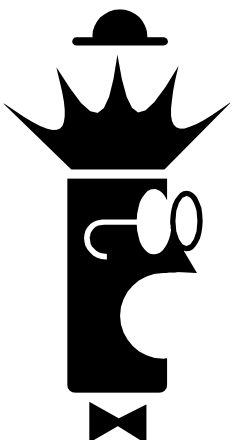
